Changes:

#1 P Lafitte	-p	to P B-1113! 35	A slight decline in value, was to be replaced by 3 rd round pick anyway.
#18 S Rudel	CB,+C!	to CB 3-4-4! 29	Sometime starting safety more physical, moves to CB to pound TE's.
#26 H Haraldsson	+c	to H 3-2-6o im 26	Keeps speed and becomes more physical, and big passing threat too!
#27 CB Doppleganger	+p	to CB 3-0-6 23	Improved pass D; Would be #1 starter on almost any other team.
#30 F Topsi	-s	to F 1-3-2 28	Decline, as well as failure to recover from injury; an inevitable cut.
#37 S Lent	+^	to S 4-1-5^ 27	Improvement to an already a top quality safety.
#43 H Shrieker	-!	to H 2-2-5 23	Improvement to very good quality; but behind 2 other better halfbacks.
#66 OLB Welchtaylor	-c	to OLB 1-1-5^ 27	Decline of starter to too poor to make final cuts, but others available.
#67 OLB Rustmonster	+s	to OLB 1-2-6 23	Sensational improvement to be one of the premium OLB's in the league.
#68 OLB Thunder	+p	to OLB 2-2-5 26	Marginal improvement to backup to be more useful against the pass.
#75 DT Cremer	-c	to DT 2-4# 28	Decline of marginal starter to quality that won't make the cut.
#79 DT Quangtri	+p^,DE	to DE 1-4-2^ 25	Big Improvement from a marginal DT to a starting quality DE.

Injuries:

- #30 F Topsi failed to recover from (-s), declined to F 1-3-2 28 and was released.
- #66 OLB Welchtaylor recovered from -c (but declined and will likely be released anyway).
- #68 OLB Thunder -c, 1g, is OK for Preseason game 1.
- #89 DE Chamberlain -s, 3g, would be OK for G1 but stashed on TIR.
- #86 DE Zrzavy -s, 2g, is OK for Preseason game 2.
- #96 DE Nervestinger, -s, OK for preseason game 1 but was released.

Summary: Electrum had a good camp and saw important improvements for several players, most notably Rudel (to most physical CB in league), Haraldsson (to one of top few Halfbacks in league), Dopppeganger (to superior starting quality cover CB), Rustmonster (to one of best OLB's in league), Quangtri to starting DE, 2nd pick Lurkerabove to starting quality safety, Umberhulk to starting quality DT, and several other players from marginal to solid backup quality. Electrum definitely addressed all the weaknesses they had, especially on defense, with a more solid line and more beef in the secondary, and improvement at every position. They may be able to use a bit more size against the run but are better than they were. At OLB they have better depth now as well as a superior OLB, which they were missing before. The few player declines were to marginal or backup players who are not really needed given the massive improvements, or an unremarkable starter replaced by someone at least as good (F, OLB). their holes are easily filled in. Injuries mattered not at all, and Electrum is projected to start the season with no injured players. Electrum goes from being the surprisingly upset division favorite of Season XI to likely being a massive favorite for Season XII. Are they keeping pace with the enormously improved Jade team? The Season XII championship may tell us.
